On behalf of the staff and the Trustees we wish you all a blessed Easter filled with love, laughter, and unforgettable memories.

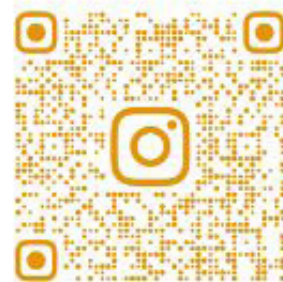
